VA's C&P Clinic Moves to Whipple Federal Building

The VA's Compensation & Pension (C&P) Clinic has moved to the first floor of the Whipple Federal Building, located at 1 Federal Drive, on the Fort Snelling Upper Post.

It's previous space at the Minneapolis VA Medical Center will be renovated for an expanded Chronic Pain Rehabilitation Program.

The new C&P clinical and office space is located on the first floor of the Whipple Building. In addition, three audiology booths and an imaging suite are located in the basement.

The C&P exam evaluates veterans for medical conditions related to military service. The C&P examiner's report goes to the VA Regional Benefit Office (RO), where claims for benefits are processed. The RO, not the C&P examiner, decides whether a veteran is entitled to disability compensation or pension.

The RO is located in the Whipple Building. The co-location of the VA's C&P Clinic with the RO is intended to assist veterans.

Veterans have been notified via appointment letters of the new location. If veterans come to the Minneapolis VAMC, a shuttle van is available to take veterans to the Whipple Building. An open house in the new C&P Clinic is planned October 22, 2-4 pm.
