

**RADIOGRAPHY PROGRAM - VA School of Radiologic Technology
PROGRAM EFFECTIVENESS DATA**

Graduate follow up surveys occur within 6 months following graduation. Information updates occur as graduate surveys are received and analyzed each year. Rates published per JRCERT requirements are the following:

Registry Exam Passing Rate

Five-year average credentialing examination (American Registry of Radiologic Technologists Radiography exam) pass rate of not less than 75 percent at first attempt within six months of graduation.

5-year average	91%	91.3% or 42 out of 46 students passed on first attempt

Program completion rate

The definition of program completion is the number of students who complete the entire clinical and didactic phase of the program within 150% of the stated program length. The program length for the VA School of Radiologic Technology is 24 months and program completions are those students graduating within 36 months of beginning the program.

2016	100%	10 began, 10 graduated
2017	86%	7 began, 6 graduated

Employment Rate

Five-year average job placement rate of not less than 75 percent within twelve months of graduation.
 **Note—2008-2012 JRCERT Standards asked for employment data within 6 months of graduation. Standard changed in 2014 to 12 months post-graduation. For some years the data is known for both 6 months and 12 months.

Year	Percent Job Placement	Number of Students
5-year average	6 months – 96% 12 months – 100%	49 out of 51 = 96% employed within 6 months of graduation. 51 out of 51 = 100% employed within 12 months of graduation
2015	91% 100%	10 of 11 employed within 6 months of graduation - 1 pursuing higher education 11 of 11 employed within 12 months of graduation
2016	100% 100%	10 of 10 employed within 6 months of graduation - 1 pursuing higher education 10 of 10 employed within 12 months of graduation
2017	100% 100%	6 of 6 employed within 6 months of graduation 6 of 6 employed within 6 months of graduation
2018	92% 100%	11 of 12 employed within 6 months of graduation. 12 of 12 employed within 12 months of graduation.
